The Wearable Arts Gala (WAG) Paparoa will be held on **15th of October 2011** at the Paparoa Hall SH 12 Paparoa Northland.

Entrants Garments

Give your self-time and have your garment completed by the evening of the **Friday 14th of October** Wearable Arts Gala (WAG) full dress rehearsal at Paparoa Hall **7pm prompt** as the evening will be long.

Your garment can be left in the dressing room on the evening of Friday 14th October after dress rehearsal. We understand that often there are last minute adjustments required to be done on the night and you will find power points available for use in the dressing room.

Rehearsal

Please be aware that the day of the Wearable Arts Gala (WAG) will be a long evening and often entrants may come from further a field than Paparoa, therefore please be prepared for the possibility of a long evening. **So please be on time for the rehearsal on the Friday 14th October 2011.**

The rehearsal is a very important part of the show this is the last chance for all aspects of the show to be fine tuned such as lighting, sound, art direction, timings and the choreography of the models and entertainment to ensure a well presented show on Saturday night.

Rehearsals will start at **7pm** sharp so please ensure that yourself and your model are at the **Paparoa Hall** on time and ready to run through the show. Please insure that you & your model have your full costume & accessories for the full dress rehearsal.

The rehearsal will be around 2hrs to 3hrs long so take this time into factor when planning your evening. Tea & Coffee will be provided for the rehearsal however you may wish to bring a long nibbles, as the evening is long.

Entrants Models

Please ensure you inform your model of the time commitment required for the evening, as it is imperative that they are present for the choreography of the show.

If your model has not modelled before do not worry, as full catwalk modelling training will be provided at the rehearsal to ensure that all models are confident with their part in the show.

You will receive your show passes at rehearsal once your entry form has been returned. There will be passes for the designer & model only any helpers etc must purchase a ticket to be able to help out on the night of the show.
